I WILL GIVE GENEROUSLY

2 Corinthians 9:10–11 (HCSB)

¹⁰ Now the One who provides seed for the sower and bread for food will provide and multiply your seed and increase the harvest of your righteousness. ¹¹ You will be enriched in every way for all generosity, which produces thanksgiving to God through us.

The giving of every Christian should be:

- 1. **Cheerful**—characterized by cheerful joy
- 2. Determined—to prefer or to choose
- **3.** Enabled—to be able to meet a task

For the Christians we are to be more than just **givers**; we are to be **generous givers** and this happens when we:

- **1.** Make it a matter of prayer. *Give from the heart*
- 2. Know that God is not limited in His resources. Give beyond what you can see
- 3. Commit to give as God leads. *Give as God leads you*

Give without **hesitation** and without **restriction**.

Give of your <u>TIME</u>. Give of your <u>TALENT</u>. Give of your <u>TREASURE</u>.

"We are not enemies of God, we are sons (and daughters) and we are free." Let this truth drive **WHO** we are, **WHAT** we do and **HOW** we give.
